Information on transfer from Hong Kong International Airport to HKUST

Taxi

The most convenient way is taking taxi directly from the Airport to HKUST. Under normal traffic conditions, the fare should be less than HK\$400 (including all tunnel fees, luggage fees etc.). You must pay in cash in local currency. The trip takes about 45 minutes. Taxi drivers usually can speak simple English. You can print the campus map of HKUST, with the name of HKUST in Chinese, and show it to the taxi driver if necessary:

Airport Express and taxi

You can take the Airport Express (express train between the Airport and a few stations in the city) and go to the Kowloon Station. You can find the price (a single journey ticket is HK\$90) and other details of the Airport Express in the Airport's web site and the MTR web site:

At Kowloon Station, you can take a taxi to HKUST and the taxi fare is about HK\$150.

Airport bus and taxi

Airport bus is not recommended since the trip of the bus takes pretty long and sometimes the bus is crowded. If you take it, here is the most direct route. Please take Airport bus number E22A. The destination of this bus is "Tseung Kwan O" ("Po Lam"). Tseung Kwan O is a region located not far away from HKUST and Po Lam is a community in Tseung Kwan O. The cost is HK\$24. You have to pay the exact fare. You get off the bus in Po Lam bus terminal (the trip takes about 60 to 90 minutes). In the bus terminal, you can take a taxi to HKUST and the fare is about HK\$40.
